WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

- Heating equipment fires account for 1 in 10 house fires.
- Heating equipment is the second leading cause of house fires.
- In 29% of house heating fires, the cause is a lack of routine maintenance of heating equipment.

HEATING EQUIPMENT

BE SAFE.

Some simple steps can prevent most heatingrelated fires from happening. Practice proper routine maintenance and safety precautions.

WHAT IS HEATING EQUIPMENT?

- Wood stove
- Fireplace
- Space heaters

PROTECT YOUR FAMILY.

- Have your heating system and chimneys inspected and cleaned annually by a qualified technician.
- Ensure all outside heating vents are clear.
- Always have woodstoves, fireplaces, and fireplace inserts installed by a qualified technician.
- Allow ashes from your woodstove or fireplace to cool before emptying them into a metal container with a tight-fitting lid. Keep the container outside.
- Always use a fire screen around the fireplace.



All homes with a fuel-burning appliance, fireplace or attached garage must have a working carbon monoxide alarm installed outside all sleeping areas.
